



Opening: Saturday, February 3, 2024, MOCA BANGKOK inaugurated the exhibition titled "Twilight Zone 4". This exhibition features the works of Chuang Moolpinit, who is recognized as the 2014 National Artist of Thailand. The inauguration of the exhibition was attended by Mr. Chuan Leekpai. "Twilight Zone 4" will be displayed at Temporary Exhibition 1 and 2, G Floor, MOCA BANGKOK from February 4 to February 25, 2024.

Chuang Moolpinit had the privilege to pursue the study of academic painting under the mentorship of Professor Silpa Bhirasri. As a result, he obtained an Associate of Arts degree from the Faculty of Painting at Silpakorn University. Moolpinit is able to express himself artistically using many approaches and tactics inside this educational system. Throughout his career, he has produced various works of art, such as writings, drawings, paintings, and sculptures. Moolpinit derives inspiration for his artistic pursuits from Buddhist stories, literary works, poetry, and traditional Thai art forms.

Nature is the foundation upon which Chuang Moolpinit builds his imaginative world. The unusual combination of principles and nature in his paintings sets him apart from other artists. His subjects include humans, animals, and symbols. As a result, his paintings include both mundane and sacred narratives. Along the artistic route of Chuang Moolpinit, artists have discovered a means to express himself via his works, which span over half a century. Moonpinit is a frequent participant in both solo and group shows. In 2013, Chuang Moonpinit was honored as a national artist of Thailand in Visual Arts (Painting).

Since 2013, Chuang Moolpinit has been calling his solo exhibition the Twilight Zone. This time, the exhibition is "The Twilight Zone 4", therefore his Twilight Zone has a different connotation than the realm the twilight that most people associate with. Moolpinit's Twilight Zone comes from his meditation on the truth shown by his aging physique. It appears that the sun is about to set. It's almost time to leave. The sky will gradually darken, although not yet fully. The twilight zone reflects the fact that the sun must set. Humans are born and must die. The work's content, in addition to exhibiting the aesthetic splendour of the artist's work and the ability to create whatever his heart desires. It alludes to a time of artistic creation in his later years.
